



To Whom It May Concern,

RACO, BELL, TAYMAC, WIEGMANN, and Acme Electric Products are considered "ARTICLES" under 29 CFR 1910-1200, the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard, and do not require a Safety Data Sheet (SDS).

Articles are specifically exempt from the regulations of this standard. OSHA defines an article as follows:

1910-1200(c) – *Article* means a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle:

- i. Which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture;
- ii. Which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and
- iii. Which under normal conditions does not release more than very small quantities.
